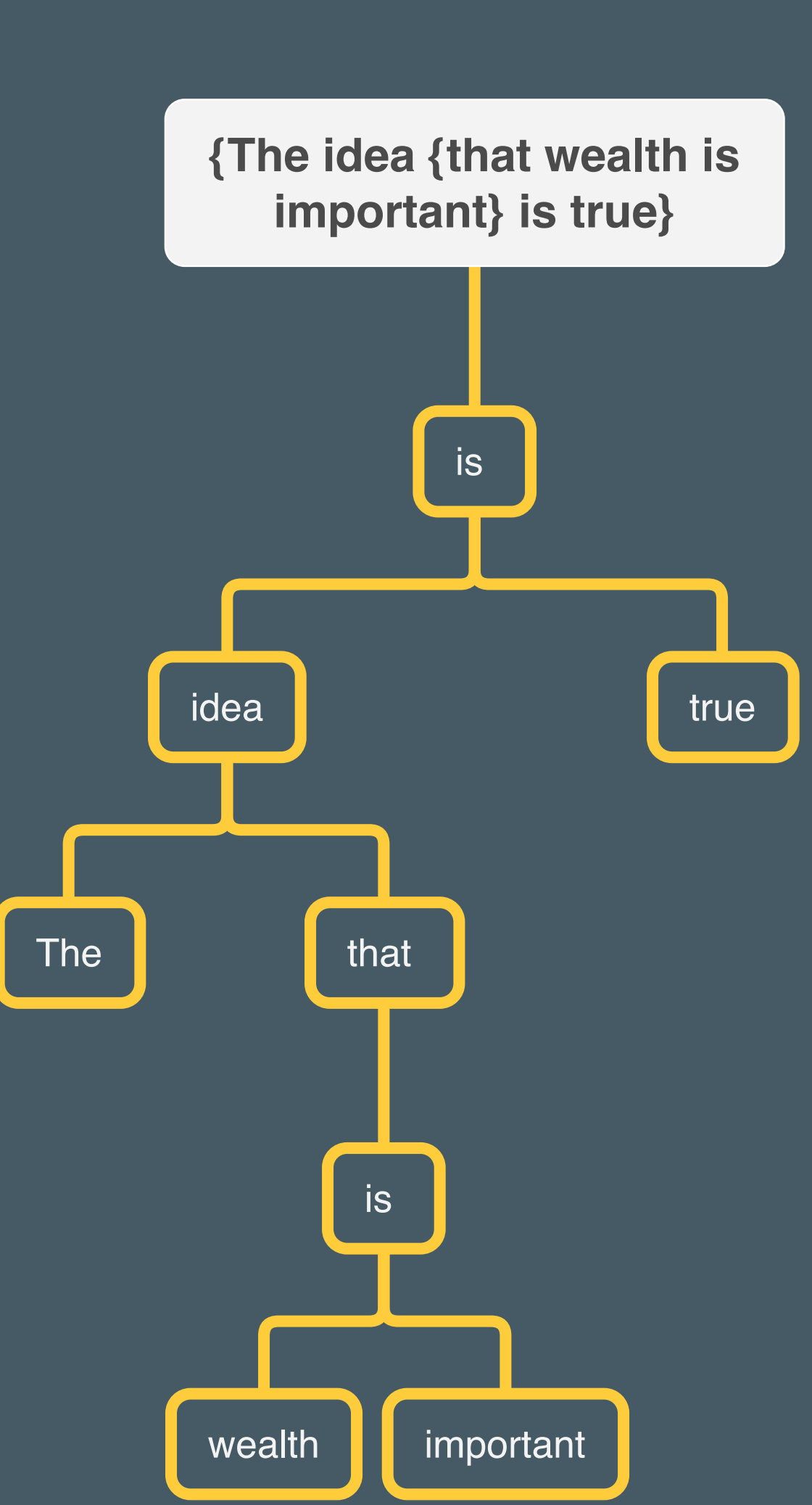

Anne B asks: Which of these are good clause breakdowns for the sentence?

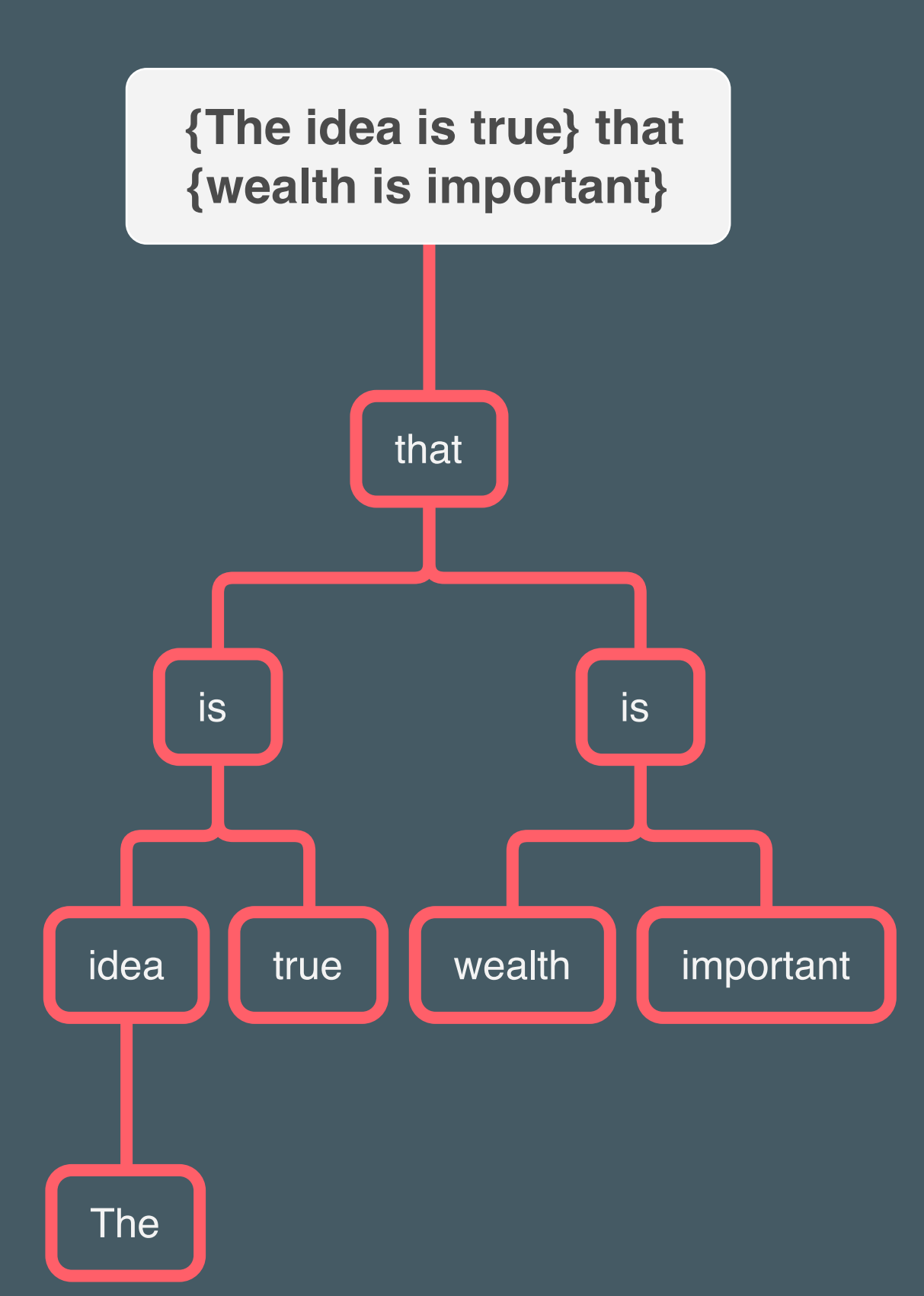
J attempts to represent Anne B's groupings in tree form, and then attempts the same with Elliot's version.

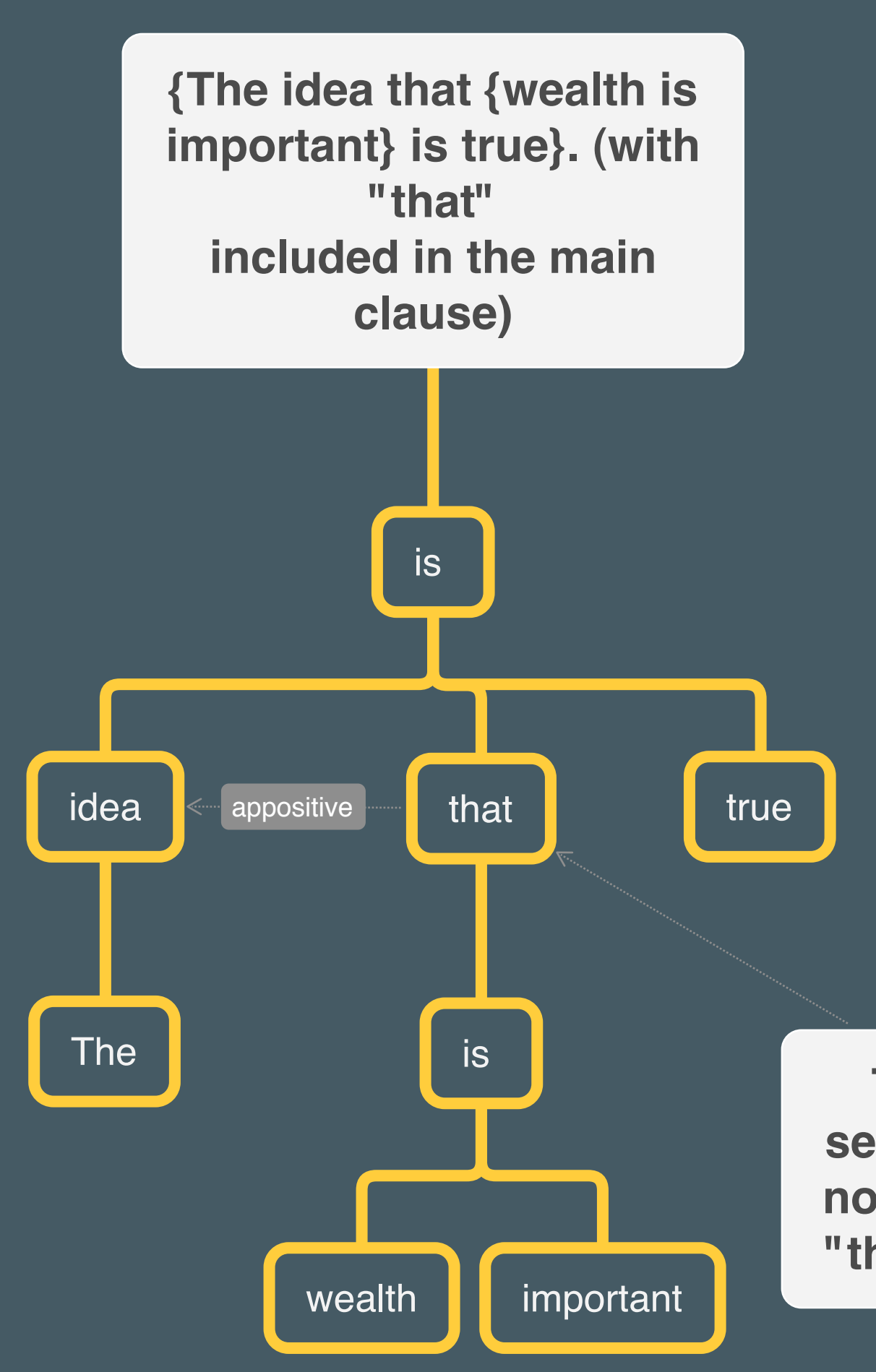

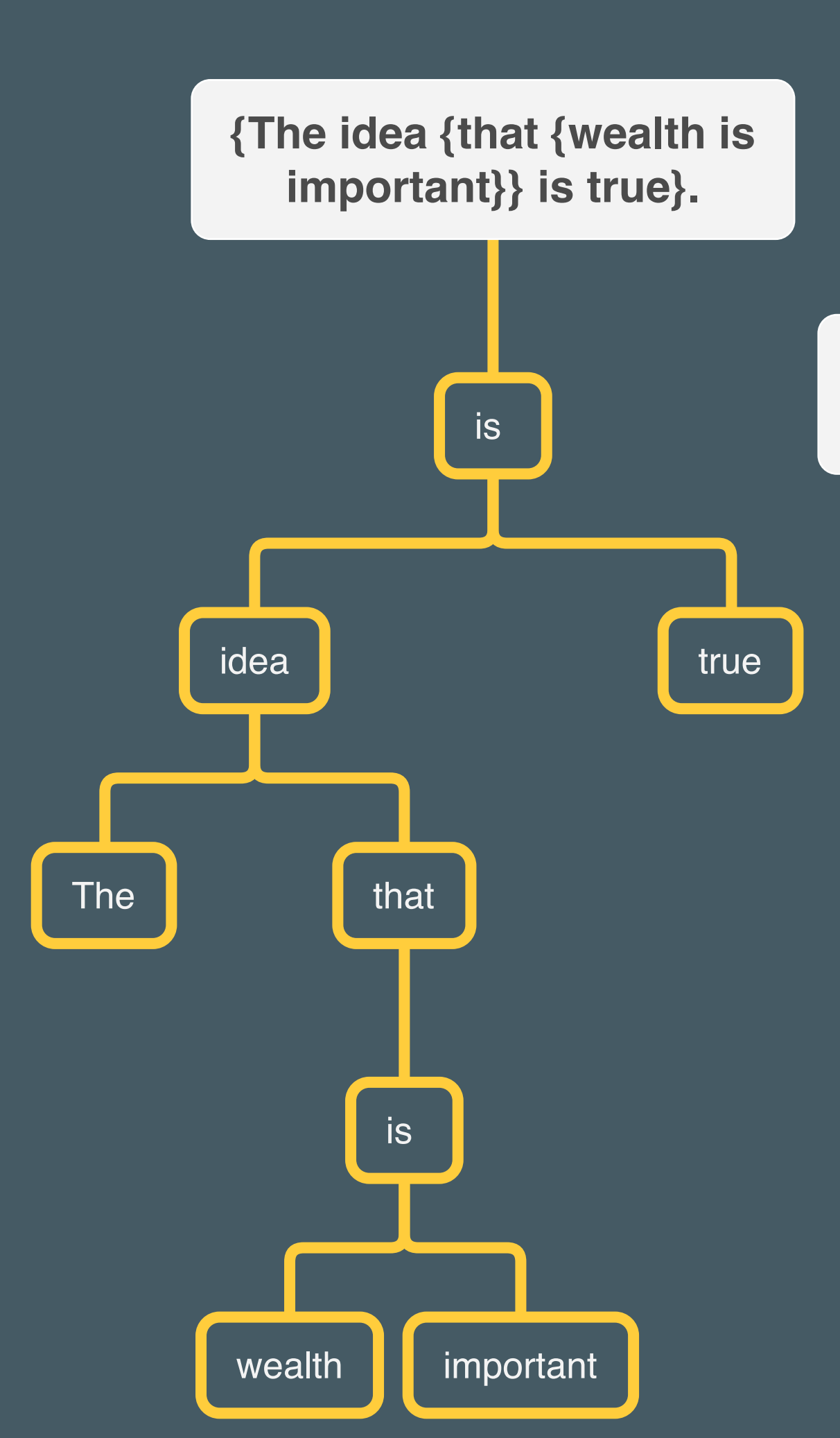

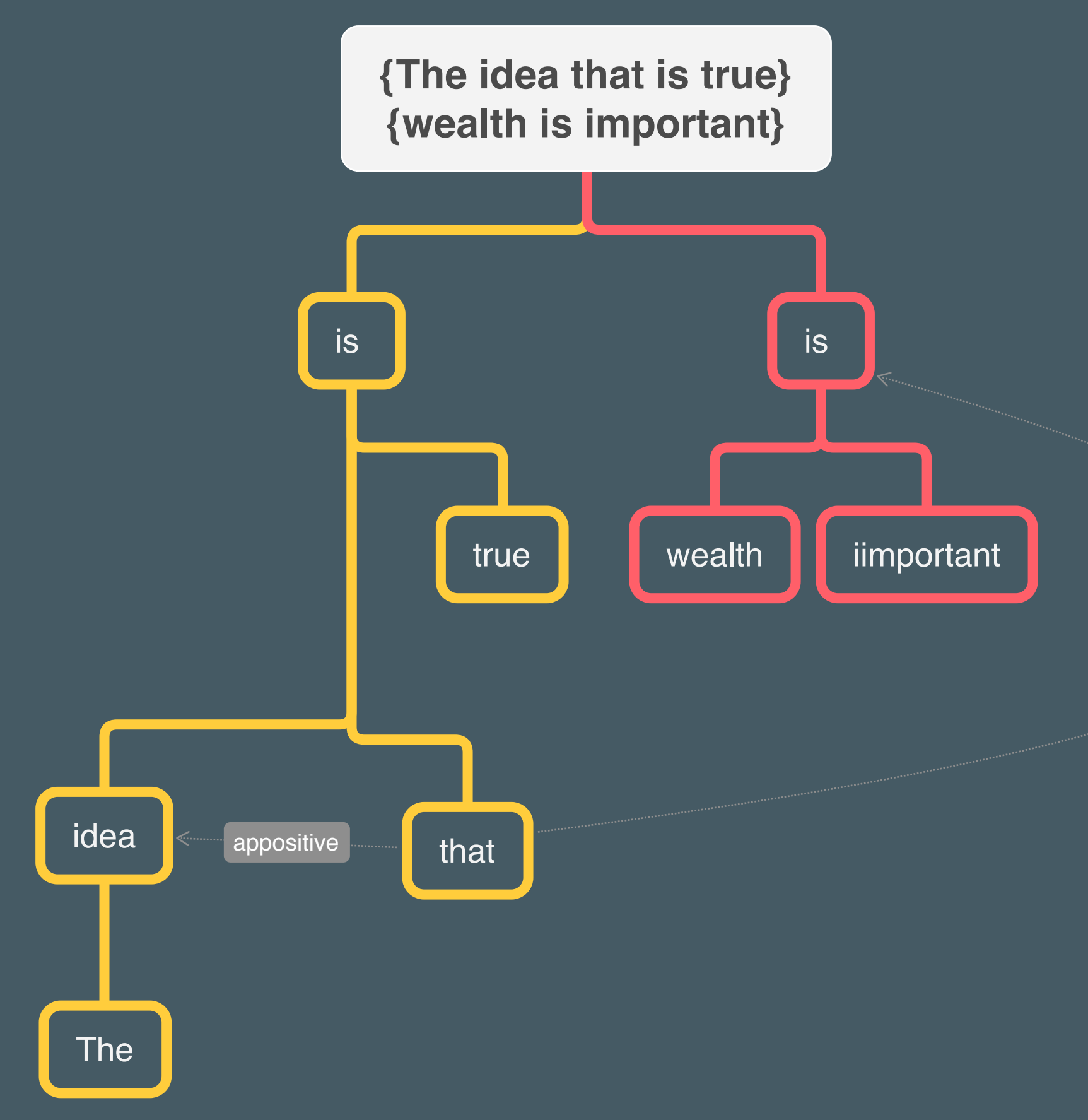
This one makes less sense to me - seems like no good/logical place for "that" in the main clause
